Hardware stop if OSTEMPLATE is large.

Example: I created osteamplate from VM, size 1.5GB and restaured in new hardware. Hardware stoped in create. I deleted large logs and created OSTEMPLATE again. Size is 450Mb. I restore normal in new hardware, hardware no stop.

Because large OSTEMPLATE stop hardware?

I have this problem in 2 new hardwares. Use RHEL4 64
