I use Gentoo OpenVZ kernel: sys-kernel/opencvz-sources-2.6.18.028.053-r2

Vzctl: 3.0.22

sysctl config is ok, double checked.

i have two network interfaces:

Private: eth0 (192.168.1.0/24)

Pubic: eth1 (193.200.0.0/24)

I set VPS and set private ip to VPS and vps had nice connection to internet and everything. then i try to give public ip 193.200.0.18 to VPS and then vps could ping default gateway 193.200.0.1, but all other internet could not be accessed.
