I created a new VE by the following commands

```
# vzctl create 111 --ostemplate ubuntu-8.04-i386-minimal
# vzctl set 111 --ipadd 10.0.0.1 --save
# vzctl set 111 --hostname u8 --save
# vzctl start 111
```

But i always get
