Since everything I've found via search is years old...

I have 2 different VPSs on 2 different hostnodes, both running Ubuntu 7.01. Hostnode is CentOS 5 x86\_64.

Both only have 1 process left running, which is init.

I've done the `vzctl stop VEID --fast` on both

I've attached the 2 strace files for them.

Any help would be appreciated. I do not want to reboot the nodes, as that will be problematic for the other customers.
