I currently am trying to mount a OCFS2 disk with iSCSI in a VE. I am able to get it working correctly in a non-VE, but when I run the following command I get some errors:

```
# /etc/init.d/o2cb restart
Loading module "configs": OK
Mounting configs filesystem at /config: mount: unknown filesystem type 'configs'
Unable to mount configs filesystem
Failed
```

The OCFS2-Tools tries to mount a filesystem that the VE doesn't allow. The host node is able to mount it though.

Has anybody been successful with this before?
