I currently am trying to mount a OCFS2 disk with iSCSI in a VE. I am able to get it working correctly in a non-VE, but when I run the following command I get some errors:

/etc/init.d/o2cb restart Loading module "configfs": OK Mounting configfs filesystem at /config: mount: unknown filesystem type 'configfs' Unable to mount configfs filesystem Failed

The OCFS2-Tools tries to mount a filesystem that he VE doesn't allow. The host node is able to mount it though.
