My Hardware node has one NIC call eth0, I assigned IP: 10.x.x.10/24, gateway: 10.x.x.1 this ip can access to the internet.

I created 2 VPS with hostname call are node1 and node2

In node1, I assigned IP: 192.168.1.2

In node2, I assigned IP: 192.168.1.3

When I start VPS have this message:

```
arp send: 192.168.1.2 is detected on another computer : 00:00:0c:07:ac:06  
vps-net_add WARNING: arp send -c 1 -w 1 -D -e 192.168.1.2 eth0 FAILED
```

the same problem on node2

I access to node1 and ping to 10.x.x.10 is ok
but i cannot access to 10.x.x.1 and to the internet.
