I have checked and this is a bug in couple of Red Hat patches. I suggest you recompile with CONFIG_XFRM option turned on. You can file a bug to <http://bugzilla.redhat.com>, saying their kernel 2.6.18-92.1.1.EL5 can not be compiled w/o CONFIG_XFRM
