I know that my question is maybe a minor issue but I don't find clues to solve it. Few months ago I built a new container, CentOS 5 and I installed vsftpd without troubles. But, since 1 or 2 months I have problems with ftp service.

Obviously, ftp service is running, and if I do

`netstat -a`

So ftp is listening! I don't have any messages or messages about this. iptables is not installed in the container and is off on the host. But I'm confused because the first time I made the ftp service all worked well. But I don't know what happened.
