Such problem could happen if you have wrong/missing routing table on both VE/HN. Please, provide more information:

- 1) ``ip route`` on both VE and HN
  - 2) ``ip --version`` on VE
  - 3) ``uname -r`` on HN
  - 4) Try to ping VE from HN and vica-versa. Results?
  - 5) Have you firewall enabled on HN?
  - 6) Have you `ip_forwarding` enabled? (Post ``sysctl -p`` from HN)
