I have created a minimal template cache from Slackware 10.2.

You can download it from <http://homaly.dunanet.hu/wvz/slackware/>
It's just 27 megs.

For the OpenVZ dev guys:
Because the current hosting site has limited bandwidth, I would be grateful if you could serve this file from openvz.org (<http://openvz.org/download/template/cache/> i guess).

Creating it was easy, I just copied a running host's root directory into a private area then followed kir's howto on debian template cache creation.

I have renamed the template to slackware-10.2-i386-minimal to better suit our naming conventions. I think it should work with vzctl, since there is a generic slackware.conf in `/etc/sysconfig/vz-scripts/dists/` directory. If it is not working, please file a bug to vzctl.
