Hi.

i assume you are trying to use 2.6.18 RHEL5 based OVZ kernel.

- \* if your HostOS is a 32bit system - use OVZ kernel with PAE support
- \* if your system is 64bit (x84\_64/ia64) - OVZ kernel (there only one kernel for these arches) should see all 16Gb.

Please, let us know if this helps or not.

If not, please, post here host OS and the native kernel that sees all 16 Gb and exact OVZ kernel (version, arch) that you try.
