Has anyone ever experienced blank output from "rpm -qa" in a container?

I created a Fedora 10 template using vzpkgcache command and my own metadata list of packages.

Tried "rpm --rebuilddb" to no avail.

/dev/urandom had somehow been turned into a file instead of a proper device file. I thought I had already checked that, but I must have been in the wrong VE. Once /dev/urandom had been recreated properly, everything worked just fine.
