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Hi,

I've a script to gather the containers net usage, currently using the following:
vzctl exec CID cat /proc/net/dev

The problem

If the container is reaching it's privvmpages, kmemsize, etc, I won't be able to retrieve the data, if the container is restarted in the meantime I won't be able to account the bandwidth usage.

Solution

If was able to access to it (container's /proc/net/dev) from the HN I would be able to gather the data even if the CID is out of resources
