Hi,

I'm trying to use vldump to back up a VM using this command:

```
sudo vldump --compress --dumpdir /home/backup --stop 102
```

But the dump fails. I've included the last few lines of the log file below which I think contain the relevant error messages but I get loads of errors similar to the first line about failing to set times.

Can anyone help with this?

```
