I created a conference number 3000 with PIN of 1234. I dial into the conference and I am prompted for the PIN but when I enter the PIN I get that is not a valid conference PIN number.

The attached log shows:

"app_meetme.c: Unable to open pseudo device"

The problem is that Elastix has Asterisk 1.4.23 and is using DAHDI which is due to replace Ztdummy so when I followed this:

it didn't help much.

I even downloaded the Asterisk 1.4.24 and recompiled Asterisk but that didn't help either. Please see the attached log.
