I can boot into Fedora perfectly fine but booting into the OpenVZ kernel causes all sorts of errors with symbols all over the screen lol.

Should I switch to the stable kernel?

I believe, the only needed packages are those, that are in requirements of rpm-package, otherwise it's a BUG:
