i am running ubuntu 8.04 server kernel 2.6.24 on Intel 64bit dual processor machine.i had intel PRO/1000 PT quad port network interface which was working fine.i installed openvz stable release with kernel 2.6.18-14-ovz-amd64-smp.This enviromnent did not detect the interface.i downloaded the driver from intel website.it is e1000e-1.0.2.5 for linux.when i did 'make install' to install this driver following error has been shown.
