Hi !

ISPconfig is a control pannel to administrate a shared hosting solution, it will administrate services like Apache, ProFTPd, MySQL and Bind. But ISPconfig isn't a control pannel to administrate OpenVZ.

So, you can install ISPconfig inside an OpenVZ container without problem just follow these guides :

- For Debian Lenny + ISPConfig 3:

For ISPConfig 3 pay attention to the README, because there are a note about the installation in a OpenVZ container !
