Quote:Source install: No go on any distro I've tried it on. Deb 5 Package Install: Good on my box, on the openvz it fails on the SQL setup with both mysql and postgresql (fresh installs just like mine, but apparently subtly broken)

i forget the exact error messages, but there were a lot of them

it wouldn't even let me try to configure mysql

on postgresql it messed up trying to create the tables

created some but not all, and complained about the missing entries
