I have CentOS server with openVZ (2.6.18-164.15.1.el5.028stab068.9)

I downloaded CentOS template from here
<http://download.openvz.org/template/precreated/centos-5-x86.tar.gz>

then tried to create with this simple command

```
vzctl create 101 --ostemplate centos-5-x86 --hostname=vm101
```

then I entered in VM
and got this output from top command:

```
