root@backuppc:/# mount /dev/sdc1
```

```
mount: block device /dev/sdc1 is write-protected, mounting read-only
```

```
mount: cannot mount block device /dev/sdc1 read-only
```

in config i've got:

```
DEVNODES="sdc1:rw "
```

and THAT way it worked in 2.6.18

now on 2.6.24 it doesnt.

i have to manually write a line like this:

```
vzctl set 103 --devnodes sdc1:rw --save
```

then i can mount the drive, but after ve or vh restart - same story.

no patches plz, i dont know, how to recompile kernels.

```
DEVNODES="sdc:rw sdc1:rw" to get it working.
```
