I am trying to create new VE with Fedora or CentOS (tried Debian and Ubuntu 10.04 and everything OK) downloaded from <http://wiki.openvz.org/Download/template/precreated>

vzctl create 117 --ostemplate centos-4-x86 --config machines15
```
