Server with 6 containers worked fine about a year, but after last reboot I can't start one VZ.

I examined the server and found additional problems, in particular, a memory errors and kernel oopses, which was not at the time of writing the top post. After memory replacement all VE's starting and running fine.

My mistake was that I had not tried to reboot the server before posting - but it was impossible at the moment.

So I'm sure that root cause is hardware fault.
