debian-add_ip.sh: fixlet for Ubuntu networking

In Ubuntu's /etc/init/networking.conf there are the following lines:

```
start on (local-filesystems
        and stopped udevtrigger)
```

Our templates change it to:

```
start on local-filesystems
```

The problem is after apt-get upgrade this file is recreated and these modifications are lost. We have to take care of fixing it on every IP adding operation.
