How do I passthrough a usb HDD (ntfs) to a container?

I manage to get it to show up in the container under fdisk using the following command:

```
#vzctl set 1000 --devnode /dev/sdc1:rw --save
```

However, I can't mount it:

```
#ntfsmount /dev/sdc1 /mnt/Media -o force
fuse: failed to open /dev/fuse: Operation not permitted
fuse_mount failed.
Unmounting /dev/sdc1 (Media)
```

```
#modprobe fuse
```

```
WARNING: All config files need .conf: /etc/modprobe.d/00local, it will be ignored in a future
release.
```

```
FATAL: Could not load /lib/modules/2.6.32-4-pve/modules.dep: No such file or directory
```

```
#ls /lib/modules
```

```

If I copy (I know.. it won't work lol.. I was trying anything) it...

```
#cp -r 2.6.32-3-686 2.6.32-4-pve
```

```
#modprobe fuse
```

```
FATAL: Error inserting fuse (/lib/modules/2.6.32-4-pve/kernel/fs/fuse/fuse.ko): Invalid module
format
```

```
# HN: load kernel module, configure passthrough
echo fuse >> /etc/modules
modprobe fuse
```

```
vzctl set 123 --devnodes fuse:rw --save
```

```
# VE: check permissions
```

```
ls -l /dev/fuse /usr/bin/fusermount
```
