Is there any way to get same functionality that `kernel.pid_ns_hide_child=1` does (with `>=2.6.24`) but RHEL5 kernels?

The problem is that some service runs both on CT and HN and the service xxxx stop/start does not work on HN, because the process is "already" running... (named for example).
