We have a cpanel vps user on our openvz linux based node. We have been battling a situation with his vps for the past 2 months. It seems whenever he gets a lot of mysql query's the load on his vps goes up considerably. We have it set so he can use 100% of all 8 cores on the node and yet the load still goes up to around 30-90 on the node.

Is this bad coding on his site? Bad mysql config? We are lost. Below is his current mysql config:

```
