It is added to vzctl (--name) and vzlist (-n parameter) utilities. VE can be referred by name assigned using vzctl's --name parameter. /etc/vz/names directory contains the name references in format name.conf

examples:

```
set VE name:
vzctl set <VPSID> --name <NAME> --save
enter VE by name:
vzctl enter <NAME>
list all VEs with name field:
vzlist -a -n
```

From a brief look - there is no way to unset the name with vzctl, only by deleting the corresponding file in /etc/vz/names.
