Hi,

Try doing this:

- 1) letting the HN establish an internet connection automaticly
- 2) enable IPv4 forwarding & routing on ur wlan0 (no DHCP needed for this btw)
- 3) set the default route of eth0 to wlan0
- 4) done

that should actually make all VE-devices (assuming on eth0) route to the wlan0 device and therefor to the internet

would be nice if it worked or not, havent tried it myself.
