Basically you have two options:

1. Use compat-gcc-33 to compile your kernel module. I assume something like this will do the trick:

```
yum install compat-gcc-33
```

```
make CC=gcc33
```

2. Rebuild our kernel with your default GCC version:

```
rpmbuild --rebuild --target=i686 ovzkernel*.src.rpm
```

If you use x86\_64, fix --target argument accordingly (or do not use it at all as this will be a default on that platform).
