> combination of options brings other errors ;-o  
> At least building an patched kernel w/o openvz at all is  
> currently impossible ...

> Here's a little start:

>

> include/linux/vsched.h:25: error: syntax error before "int"

>

> This might come from the #define in sched.h, when CONFIG\_SCHED\_VCPU  
> is not enabled, which aliases vcpu\_online(cpu) to cpu\_online(cpu).

>

> Maybe should just leave off "(cpu)" ?

>
