Excuse me, I haven't included that:

error log remains empty, so I assume VPS script are not trying launch it - or rather fails to launch it.

Script that launches ok is local. So I put /etc/init.d/mysql start inside and - surprisingly - after VPS restart local is now off... so my VPS refuses to launch mysql automagicaly

I can include (siplified) script:

```
/etc/init.d/vz stop  
/etc/init.d/vz start  
/usr/sbin/vzctl exec 106 /etc/init.d/mysql restart
```

Output:

```
/etc/init.d/mysql: line 326: /var/run/svc-started-mysqld: No such file or directory  
* Stopping mysql ... [ ok ]  
* Starting mysql ...  
* Starting mysql (/etc/mysql/my.cnf)  
* MySQL NOT started (0)  
[ !! ]
```

Like I said before: launching the third line (/usr/sbin/vzctl exec 106 /etc/init.d/mysql restart) from shell starts mysql sucessfully
