> but this code exists in OpenVZ. And there we use per-container id for this.

Right and currently in OpenVZ you don't have anything finer. If you look at cases like nested containers. It becomes fairly clear we want a per network namespace id for this operation not a per container id. As a per container id can be ambiguous.
