> A struct pid_nr associates a pid_t value with a pid namespace. We attach
> a list of struct pid_nr entries to a struct pid (pid->pid_nrs), allowing
> the struct pid to take different pid_t values in different namespaces.
>
> The pid->pid_nrs list and the helper functions will be used in subsequent
> functions.

Ok. Things are getting there. However in a practical sense you have spread one logical change over several patches and the review is a pain because things are too fine, and cases of code movement don't look it because they are split over multiple patches.

I think patches 4,5,6,7,8 all should be a single patch that just splits struct pid_nr from struct pid.
