If you backup your VPS'es on the same machine, you can do it more simple:

By cron, on hardware node.

```
# cat vps_backup.sh
```

```
#!/bin/sh
```

```
vps_id=$1
```

```
vzprivate="/run/vz/private/"
```

```
backupdir="/run/backup/"
```

```
cd $vzprivate/$vps_id/;
```

```
tar czf $backupdir/vps/vps.$vps_id.`date +%a`.tgz .
```

```
#crontab -l
```

```
