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Actually I don't know why the wiki suggests to use proxy\_arp and add static routes on the bridge device. Besides a minimal speedup proxy\_arp may give, i see no more dvantages, only disadvantages like you stated then you want to move VE from one HN to another HN, all the hosts in the LAN will need their arp entries updated.

So in my setup i have a default transparent bridging setup with proxy\_arp and forwarding disabled, thus then the the VE is moved between HNs it's transparent for the VE clients in the LAN.

The only thing you need to be careful about is to make sure the real ethX device has the smallest mac address among all veth's enslaved to the bridge.
