And now you need to run ldconfig

Quote:I use Gentoo and I think I need:
sys-fs/sshfs-fuse

Yeah, I guess at this point it's better to

1. undo your changes to /etc/ld.so.conf
2. rerun ldconfig
3. do 'make uninstall' for fuse and sshfs-fuse (the same way you did 'make install')
4. run 'emerge sshfs-fuse' and it will emerge it and all its dependencies.

After that it should work.
