sorry, the last statement looks a bit contradictory to the prev quote. Can you make it clear for me? do you see the same bug, w/o eth1 delegated to VPS?

You're right, it is. If I think about it, the virtualized eth1 most likely has nothing to do with it. I tried to reproduce the error locally on another computer but the tcpsndbuf goes back to 0 while there is no traffic, so it might be related to some obscure kernel setting or to the hardware.

I also should mention that I removed the start\_net section from my vz initscript (Gentoo that is) because I don't need the venet0 interface.

I'll open a bug tomorrow.
