- > namespace associated with init_task.
- > - modify all interesting kernel threads to use the
- > kthread api instead of kernel_thread. Using kthread
- > makes the kernel threads children of keventd and always
- > in the initial namespace instance. As such we know
- > we aren't inside of any user space namespace instance.

I've added a deprecation entry for the kernel_thread export and plan to convert all users to the kthread API. Any help on that is of course greatly appreciated.
