In order to compile zaptel you need to have a kernel source tree corresponding to your current kernel. So install this rpm
<http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/rhel5-2.6.18/028stab053.4/ovzkernel-2.6.18-53.1.4.el5.028stab053.4.src.rpm>
, then zaptel should compile without problems.

I'd also like to note that if your task is to get Asterisk MeetMe working and you do not have any analog FXO cards installed, you only need to have 2 LKMs from zaptel: zaptel-base and ztdummy.
