Quote: The privmpages count persists across restarts of the VE. Does this mean it's a cumulative count of **all** memory allocations, ever, for that VE? That seems wrong, unless this parameter is not meant to be used except in unusual circumstances.

privmpages.held (as well as all other UBC parameters) shows the current usage of this resource. If a container is stopped and any parameter's held value is more than zero, this means either a resource leak or a bug in accounting -- and in both cases should be reported straight to <http://bugzilla.openvz.org/>
