OpenVZ patches (RHEL based and vanilla) shouldn't be different in logic.

What about non OpenVZ related kernel logic? I mean is it safe to run RHEL kernel on non RHEL based distribution like gentoo?

Maybe there might be some incompatibilities between the RHEL kernel and non RHEL userspace tools, like for example there are some RHEL glibc patches that need to be applied to non RHEL glibc?

Or RHEL patches should not introduce any incompatibilities to userspace tools?
