I just did vzctl set 111 --features nfs:on --save
and restarted the VE and now the mask is 0000000000000002/0000000000000002

And then i also add vzctl set 111 --features sysfs:on --save the mask is
0000000000000003/0000000000000003

So AFAI understand sysfs is least significant bit and nfs is second significant bit. And mask is in decimal or hexadecimal format.
