VE.A editing /etc/hosts

192.168.1.2 maquina2

VE.B editing /etc/hosts

192.168.1.1 maquina1

from VE.A ping maquina2

from VE.B ping maquina1

This should work, if not see if you don't have a DNS server who kill your request from one VE to another, another way to see its /etc/nsswitch.conf this file control the priority to solve a name:

hosts:        files dns
