Nope it is not exactly what I was looking for, but I think I now know that my plan will fail

My idea was to put a VLAN N on eth0, and the vlan in the bridge br0. Also, I wanted to add the VETH devices in this bridge, so that every packet which leaves the bridge through the vlan device is automatically tagged... but I suggest this isn't possible, is it?

Because I don't want the people to configure every VLAN available on the ethernet port, so I hoped I can put the device simply in a bridge (one per vlan) so their packages are always in the same vlan.
