I have the latest RHEL5 Kernel supporting OpenVZ (2.6.18-92.1.18.el5.028stab060.2) and even at the host level I get this message "audit_log_user_command(): Connection refused". It seems the only way to remove the audit message is to compile the audit option into the kernel.

Apparently, both RedHat and Fedora have this option enabled in the kernel. I'm assuming that if you enable this option in the OpenVZ kernel the problem will be solved.

For now I just live with the annoying message "audit_log_user_command(): Connection refused"
