Indeed it is strange. For the reason of hardware support, I have to stick to 2.6.27 but I will try the other one on Vbox machine.

I narrowed down to nautilus. Run icewm, if use thunar I can still mount/unmount as normal. If start nautilus and use nautilus mount the device, then quit the nautilus window, can not unmount. Run lsof in this case showing nautilus still access it. (that is unlike when run in gnome). But even I kill -15 nautilus process and lsof shows nothing now, I still not be able to unmount it y anymeans aother then logout of the session and relogin again.

As I am not sure if this is openvz bug (I think it is unlikely; or the bug in nautilus and get triggered by openvz patch; but the fact is, thunar using HAL to get the device and mount as well and it does not have problem (so not HAL problem), I tends to think it is nautilus problem and triggered by openvz patch. Not sure where to bug it though .
