You're trying to use the apf firewall inside a container?

You should first 'modprobe iptable\_mangle' on the host before starting the container. Then give the container permissions with a command like 'vzctl set 101 --iptables iptable\_mangle'.

Before trying apf you could try using iptables directly with something like 'vzctl exec 101 iptables -t mangle -L'. The apf software probably requires other netfilter modules as well.
