vzctl exec 2094 /etc/init.d/vztest  
and the VE comes to life!

```
mount -t proc proc /proc
mount -t devpts devpts /dev/pts
mount -t sysfs sys /sys
mount -t tmpfs varrun /var/run
mount -t tmpfs varlock /var/lock
mkdir -p /var/run/network
cat /proc/mounts > /etc/mtab
```

```
init 2
ifconfig lo 127.0.0.1
/etc/init.d/networking restart
```

After that I've got an idea:  
vzctl exec 2094 ls /proc  
has NO output because proc is empty! I think its not mounted.  
But why?
